Registration:

All 2017 registered Cedarburg Painting Event artists may participate free of charge.

Quick Paint Guidelines:

Paintings must be created on-site, within the event boundaries, in the true spirit of plein air painting.

A painting will be disqualified for judging if:

- the artist is found using an ipad or photos on their easel;
- the artist is standing outside the boundaries;
- or intentionally impedes the sightline of another artist.

Painting Boundary:

The artist must be standing within Ozaukee County. View map by clicking on: <http://www.co.ozaukee.wi.us/DocumentCenter/Home/View/137>. A map will be provided in your Registration Bag.

Painting and Framing Period:

2 ½ hour time limit 8am - 3:30pm Saturday, June 10, 2017.

Check-in and Material Stamping:

Painting materials MUST be stamped prior to starting to paint, at Main Street Gallery inside the Cedarburg Cultural Center.

Saturday: 8am - 1pm

Materials:

Each artist may submit **one (1) signed painting**.

- Media may include: oils, acrylics, watercolors, pastels and gouache.
- For dark colored materials, please paint a white patch to provide a legible stamping area.
- **SMALL paintings:** Maximum material size 12 inches x 12 inches of canvas, paper or board unframed.
- **FRAME width:** Maximum 4 ¼ inches.
- **MAT width:** Maximum 4 inches (watercolors).

Submissions:

2 ½ hours from time materials are stamped or by 3:30 pm, whichever comes first. *Upon completion and submission of a first painting, the artist may choose to repeat the entire process. The artist may then choose which of the two paintings to submit for competition, exhibition and sale. The unchosen painting may be submitted later as a replacement painting.*

- The quick-paint check-in stamp must be visible on the back of the painting
- Painting must be appropriately framed, mounted and securely wired for hanging.

We reserve the right to refuse any improperly framed or wired paintings, wrapped canvases, stained mats, alligator hangers, or those with wet paint on the edges.

Judging:

Wednesday, June 14, 9am - 2pm.

- Paintings will be judged by Deke Palecek, winner of the 2016 Cedarburg Plein Air Event Best of Show award.

Quick Paint Awards: Presented at Awards Ceremony, Wednesday, June 14, 6:30pm at Cedarburg Cultural Center.

- 1st place \$400
- 2nd place \$300
- 3rd place \$200

Artists awarded more than \$550 must complete a federal form W-9 prior to receiving the cash.
